Cabins

The Victoria Mekong has 35 cabins divided into three categories:

- 17 Deluxe cabins on the Main Deck, each measuring 25m2
- 16 Deluxe cabins on the Upper Deck, each measuring 25m2
- 2 Suites on the Upper Deck, each measuring 45m2

All cabins are designed with a minimalist, contemporary aesthetic, harmoniously blending interior elements with spectacular oversized windows and private balconies, allowing guests first-hand vistas of the unique natural beauty and wide open spaces of the Mekong Delta region.

Claypot Restaurant

Located on the Upper Deck, the spacious Claypot Restaurant boasts 360-degree views in a stylish, inviting setting. The restaurant features buffet dining showcasing palate-pleasing Asian and European flavors prepared by our distinguished Executive Chef.

Horizon Bar
